- **Play / pause**
- **Volume**
- **Skip back 10 seconds** button
- **Progress bar**
- **Quality**– Allows you to choose your streaming quality. High-Medium-Automatic
- **Stream Picker** – When viewing a session with multiple streams you can pick which one you want to see.
- **Speed** – Choose your own speed.
